



PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES

The grounds will be open for photography only during our normal Winery hours: Monday thru Saturday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. (closed on Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day)

Photo sessions should not be planned for a day when we have a special event at the winery. On such a day, the entire day is restricted. Please check the "Lawn Concerts" page and the "Events" page of our web site www.nissleywine.com. Because our events are not always planned well in advance, please re-check the Events page one week before your planned photo session.

Neither a fee nor a reservation would be required.

We require that minors be accompanied by their own parent or legal guardian.

Taking photos is allowed 1) near the stone-arch winery building, 2) near the historic mill, 3) on the meadows and 4) in the vineyards adjacent to Vintage Drive. It is neither allowed 1) near the residence and garage on Vintage Drive, nor 2) in the vineyards North of Stackstown Rd.

Sitting, leaning or climbing on the wooden fences is not permitted. Sitting or otherwise being in planted areas (gardens, flower beds, etc.) is not permitted.

Sitting or otherwise posing on the roadway is not permitted. Posing on the bridge is not permitted.

There are no indoor facilities for photography.
